written by James Madison and others. the Bill of Rights is  
designed specifically to be a wall of separation guaranteeing  
government doesn't interfere with citizen religious freedom,  
to protect Citizen Voters from government - not the reverse.  
(Space won't allow complete coverage of Vance's program)  
1<sup>st</sup> Amendment- Freedom of Speech, Freedom of Religion  
"Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of  
religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof: or abridging  
the freedom of speech, ..."

2nd Amendment- The 'anti-gun for citizens' people want  
hoodlums and government to have all the guns,  
unarmed citizens in the middle. There's something really  
wrong with that picture

4th Amendment-The right of persons to be secure in their  
own houses, papers... Eminent Domain should never be  
abused by government. Confiscation of private land by

In 1798, Congress passed the Sedition Act, making it a Federal crime to publish false, scandalous or malicious writing about the United States government. In 1918 another Act of Congress made it illegal to speak ill of any Branch of Government, including individual members of the Senate or House, the President and especially punished those who spoke against, or actively demonstrated in opposition to the purchase of War Bonds to fund what we call World War 1.

"Community Issues Council (CIC) lives up to its description: '*Christian Citizenship In Action*'. CIC was instrumental in getting a referendum on the November ballot that gave the people of Hillsborough County the opportunity to ask for greater enforcement of the laws regulating the sex industry. CIC is working through meetings with county and city officials to implement the majority's wish to have that happen.
