Sol Pitchon will be our Special Guest speaker. **Sol** has been President and CEO of The Pregnancy Center of Pinellas County since 1999. Sol is a Greek Jew, born in Thessalonica, Greece, who immigrated to America, and accepted Jesus Christ in 1981. Both his father and mother are Holocaust survivors. Sol is married and the father of 4 grown children and 8 grandchildren. Sol has been a resident of Pinellas County for 50 years.

Before joining the Pregnancy Center Sol was a Christian Psychotherapist, having spent 5 years in private practice. He also worked 9 years in a psychiatric hospital setting for Rapha, a Christian inpatient program. He has a BA degree from the University of South Florida, a Masters Degree in counseling from Liberty University.

As a Jewish-Christian whose parents are holocaust survivors, Sol feels a privilege and his destiny to work in the holocaust of abortion in the pregnancy center movement.

Sol's vision, along with his staff and Board of Directors, was to open the **Breath of Life Woman's Health Services and Birth Center, 1910 East Bay Drive, Largo**, to provide a continuation and discipleship for woman and their families. **The vision came to pass just a few months ago** as they opened their new 'State of the Art' when their first baby was born in the Birthing Center. They also have Sonogram for mother's and their families to see the Baby in the mother. Dr. James Dobson, and his Focus on the Family, for help in making this possible. They also have other fine offices in Pinellas.

'**M2L**', MORE2LIFE is a Pinellas Pregnancy Center program, with some federal support, teaching Abstinence in public schools to young teenagers. As us older adults realize, "actions have consequences", and "Abstinence is the only positive way to avoid negative consequences." This is truly a fine program.

On September 12, 2007 [More to Life](#) hosted the first annual formal Purity Ball for young ladies and their fathers at the Feather Sound Country Club. Makes one envious thinking of how this is probably a very wonderful memory for fathers and daughters to share for a lifetime.
